Please support us on May 23rd 2009 Flagday on Hong Kong Island


Founded in 1987 as a nonprofit organisation, we have been campaigning for the rights of the mentally handicapped and helping the families that support them. By 1995, our operations have expanded into public service and education through exhibitions, seminars and integrated programmes teaching the community about acceptance of the mentally handicapped.

With permission from the Social Welfare Department, we will be selling flags for donations on May 23rd, 2009 from 7:00 am to 12:30 pm on Hong Kong Island. Our target is to enlist the help of 2,000 volunteers to raise a donated sum of \$600,000. Proceeds will be used to sustain our services in helping the mentally handicapped and in getting more people to accept them. At the same time, we will continue to counsel parents of the mentally handicapped and help them better understand their children's rights as equals amongst a larger community.

We sincerely invite your organisation / school to help us sell flags on May 23rd. Volunteers over 14 years of age may independently join; those under 14 must be accompanied by an adult guardian. As a show of thanks, all volunteers will receive a certificate autographed by this event's special guest, Mr. Zac Kao. The organisation / school having the most participating volunteers will be presented with the "Most Active Participation" prize.
